|  | Pick a number and tell a buddy what is above, <br> below, before, and after that number. |
|  | Tell how many tens and ones a number has. |
|  | Pick a number and tell what is I more or I less <br> than that number. |
| Pick a number and tell what is I0 more or I0 less <br> than that number. |  |
|  | Cover a few numbers with pennies or cereal. <br> Have a buddy guess your hidden numbers! |
|  | Read your chart in a silly voice. Try reading like <br> a monster, a princess, a frog, or an opera <br> singer. |
