## **Go Number Fish Directions**

### **Materials Needed**

- ) 1 file folder per team
- 1 deck of Go Number Fish Cards per group (pages A-21-A-23)
- › Optional: 1 copy of Go Number Fish Directions per group

## **Directions**

Goal: Make the greater number of packs of cards.

- Decide who goes first.
- Mix up the cards. Deal five cards to each team.
- Teams place their cards behind a standing file folder so the other team can't see them.
- Place the other cards facedown in a deck.
- > Take turns.
- On each turn, choose a card behind your folder and ask if the other team has a card with the same value. You might ask, "Do you have a card with a value of twelve?"
- The other team must give you any cards it has that match what you asked for, and then you get another turn.
- If the team does not have such a card, it tells you to "go number fish." You fish by taking the top card from the deck.
- If the card has the value you asked for, show it, put it in your hand, and take another turn. If not, your turn is over.
- ) When you get three cards with the same value, you have made a pack. Place each pack faceup in front of your folder.
- The game ends when a team has no cards left.
- The team with the greater number of packs wins.

#### **Variations**

- ) Create a similar set of cards for three-digit numbers.
- Eliminate one of the three representations for each number and have players match only pairs.
- Have students create a fourth representation for each number, and require players to get all four matches to make a pack.

#### **Exit Question Choices**

- We want to add 18 to the deck. What three cards could you make for this number?
- Which representation (such as a number line, base ten blocks, or the written number) do you find challenging? Why?

#### **Extension**

Include place-value riddles in the morning routine such as There are 13 tens and 14 ones. What number is this?
